- Students are encouraged to come dressed all day in a costume that is comfortable to wear while seated and while participating in physical education;
- Students that want to change at lunch will need to do so at home. No costume bags will be permitted in the school. If parents wish to pick up their child at lunch to get them changed, please do so during the 11:45-12:40 lunch hour;
- Please keep costumes simple, without extra props (wigs, wands, etc.) or weapons (such as swords and guns);
- No scary or gory costumes; and,
- We encourage students to dress in orange and black if they do not wish to wear a costume.

Our students will be engaged in a number of Halloween related activities during the day. *Please note that due to a number of serious food allergies, if students wish to bring treats for their classmates, they need to be store purchased with ingredients listed.
